Shortening Course: Courses may be shortened by a Committee Vessel taking up position beside any mark of the course, displaying Flag S and class flags if appropriate, and making two sound signals on the approach of the leading boats. The finishing line will be between the mark and the signal mast of the Committee Boat. Where the shorten course signal applies to all Red Fleet boats, a red pennant will replace all class flags.

The finishing line will be between the mark and the signal mast of the Committee Boat. Where the shorten course signal applies to all Red Fleet boats, a red pennant will replace all class flags.
