Marks coloured red shall be rounded to port. Marks coloured green shall be rounded to starboard

- Races will start at a committee vessel (*Maclir*) in Dublin Bay, downwind of the first mark
- Having sailed the course, boats shall proceed from the last mark to the finishing line which will be at Turning Mark. The finishing line will be a transit formed by Turning Mark and the striped pole of the committee vessel, displaying a blue flag, which will be outer limit of the line.
- Having finished, boats shall not re-cross the finishing line. They shall also keep clear of other boats still racing.
- Courses may be shortened by a committee boat or rib taking up position at one of the above locations or on a line between them, displaying Flag S.

7. GSI 6.2 (prohibited areas, orange, black and green starting lines) does not apply to this series of coastal races.
8. As courses and starting sequences may be modified at the discretion of the Race Officer, competitors should continue to observe signals at the committee vessel and maintain a listening watch on VHF channel 74.
9. If circumstances require, Platonic Courses may be sailed in accordance with GSI. 14
10. The starting sequence will be as follows:

12. Boats sailing through the Muglins Sound should avoid Leac Buidhe, located, at 53° 16. 616N, 06° 05.149W at the Dalkey Island side of the Sound.(Keeping to port when approaching from Scotsmans Bay, keeping to starboard when approaching from Killiney Bay).
